Pg 351 Apologetics Bible

1 Kings 7:23

He made the Sea of cast metal, circular in shape, measuring ten cubits from rim to rim and five cubits high.

It took a line of thirty cubits to measure around it.

By pointing to the measurements for the circular bath taken from this passage (also see 2 Chronicles 4:2), many skeptics have claimed that the Bible lists an incorrect value for the mathematical constant pi (beginning with numbers 3.14159265...") that is the diameter. According to the numbers given here, the circumference appears to be 3.0. Yet it must be understood that biblical numbers are often rounded, something we still do today. For instance, instead of casually saying that an item at the store costs \$19.53, it might be said that the item is \$20; instead of saying 64,843 attended a football game, we might say there were 65,000 fans and still be considered accurate. When we consider the fact that the commonly stated value 3.14 is actually a rounding down of pi, we see that the Bible should not be faulted for using an approximation to describe a number that is infinitely complex and long.

Job 1:20-21

At this, Job got up and tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground in worship and said:

"Naked I came from my mother's womb,
and naked I will depart.


The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away;

The doctrine of reincarnation as taught in Hinduism, Buddhism, and New Age religions is an attractive belief for those who think many lifetimes are needed to reach spiritual perfection. This present passage, along with Ecclesiastes 5:15, is sometimes used in support of belief in reincarnation. Similarly, the "born again" phrase in John 3:3 is sometimes said to refer to reincarnation. However, Hebrews 9:27 says we are given only one life before we face judgment. In this light, we must heed Paul's words in 2 Corinthians 6:2, "Now is the day of salvation." This is why the apostles were so passionate about preaching the good news to those who were lost. There are no next lives in which you can get right with God. Now is your one chance. Thus, Christians ought to have a sense of urgency in telling others about Jesus, for only by faith in Him can we have peace and relationship with God.





LEAN & GREEN

CAULIFLOWER CRUST PEPPERONI PIZZA

YIELD: SERVES 2 (HALF PIZZA PER SERVING)
PER SERVING: 1 LEAN | 3 GREEN | 3 CONDIMENTS
TOTAL TIME: 45 MINUTES


INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups riced cauliflower 1-1/3 cup reduced-fat, shredded mozzarella
- cheese, divided

 ¼ cup grated parmesan
 cheese
- ☐ 1 egg ☐ ½ tsp Italian seasoning
- ☐ 1/8 tsp salt☐ 1/2 cup no sugar added tomato sauce (such as Rao's Homemade®)
- □ 10 slices turkey pepperoni

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 'F.
- Place riced cauliflower in a microwave safe dish, uncovered. Microwave for 10 minutes, stirring halfway through. Let cool, and then mix in 1/3-cup mozzarella, parmesan, egg. Italian seasoning, and salt.
- Form cauliflower mixture into a circle, about ¼-inch thick, onto a parchment-lined baking sheet."
- 4. Bake until edges are browned, about 20 minutes.
- Top crust with tomato sauce, remaining mozzarella, and pepperoni slices.
- 6. Bake until cheese is melted, about 7 to 10 minutes.





Healthy Chicken Parmesan

YIELD: 3 Serving

PER SERVING: 1 Leaner, 1 Green, 1 Healthy Fat & 3 Condiments

INGREDIENTS:

2 tsp olive oil

1 tsp chopped thyme

1 tsp chopped rosemary

1 tsp chopped Italian parsley

3 chicken cutlets (about 4 ounces

cooked each)
1/4 tsp salt

1/2 tsp pepper

1/4 cup Rao's marinara sauce

1 cup shredded part-skim

mozzarella

8 tsp grated reduced-fat parmesan

1/2 Tbsp unsalted butter, cut into

pieces

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 500°F.

In a bowl, stir oil, thyme, rosemary, and parsley. Brush both sides of chicken w/herb oil and sprinkle w/salt and pepper.

Heat a large, heavy ovenproof skillet over high heat. Add chicken cook just until browned, 1 minute per side. Remove from the heat.

Spoon marinara sauce over and around the cutlets. Sprinkle w/mozzarella, 2.6 tsp of Parmesan. Dot tops w/butter pieces bake until cheese melts and chicken is cooked 5 minutes.
